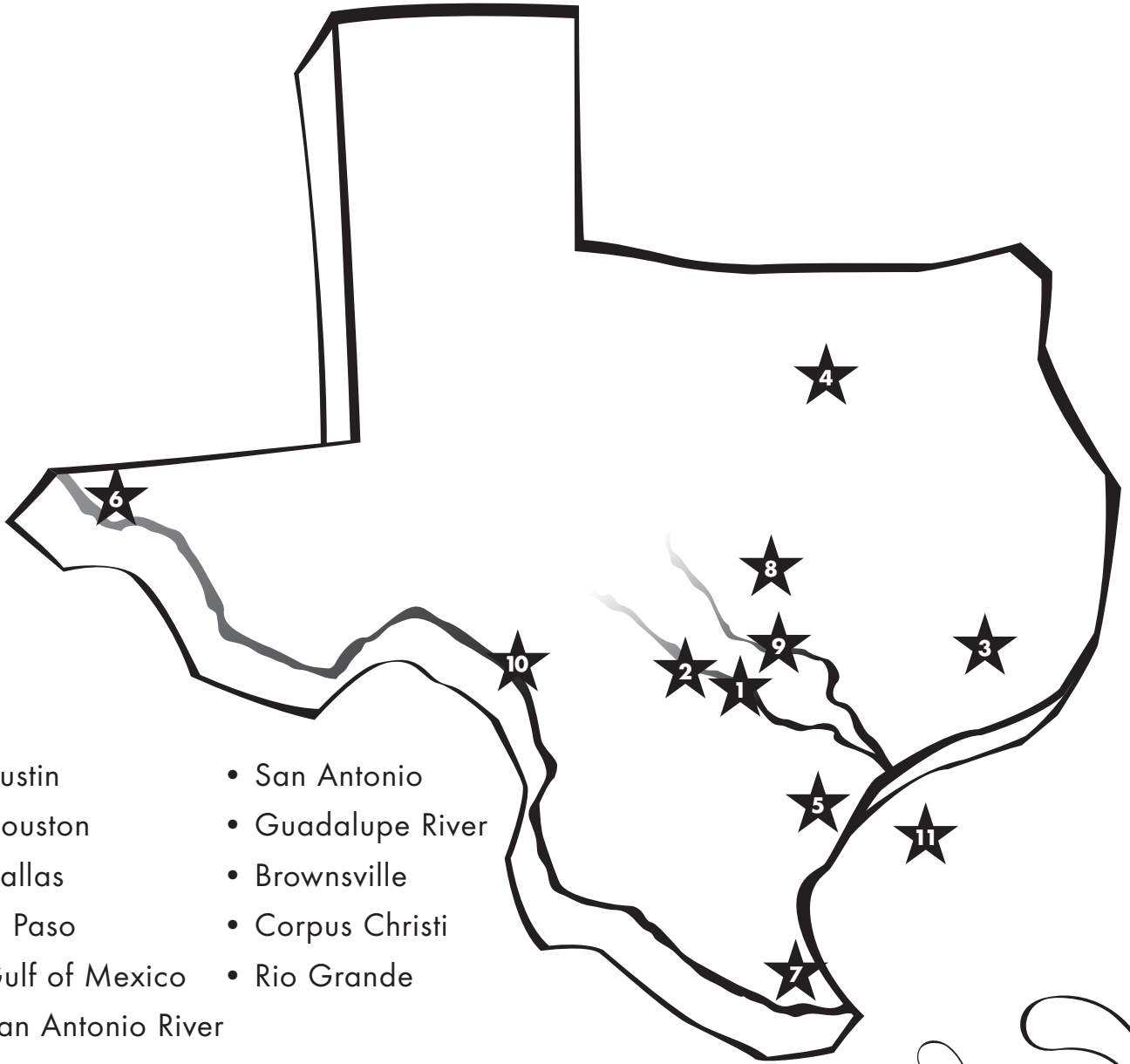
WILL'S FAST FACT

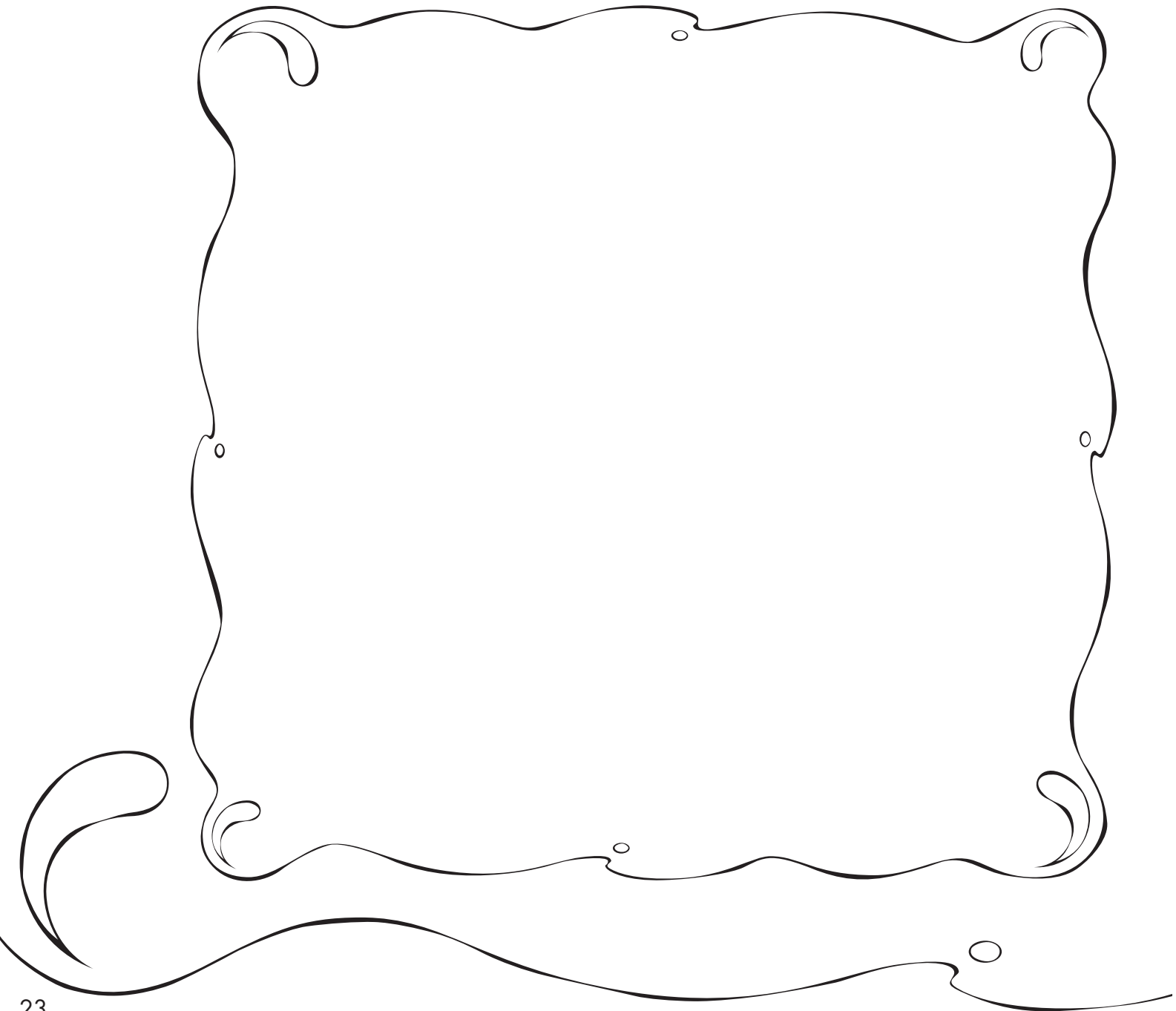

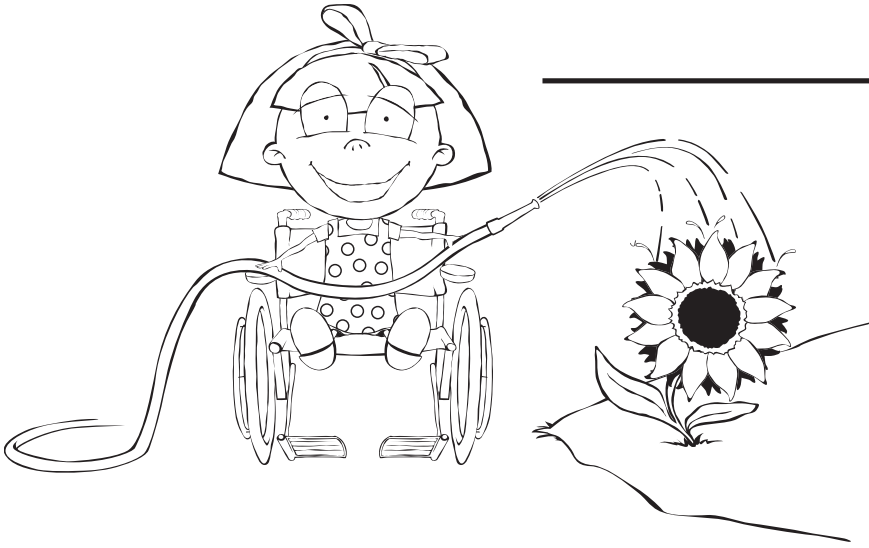

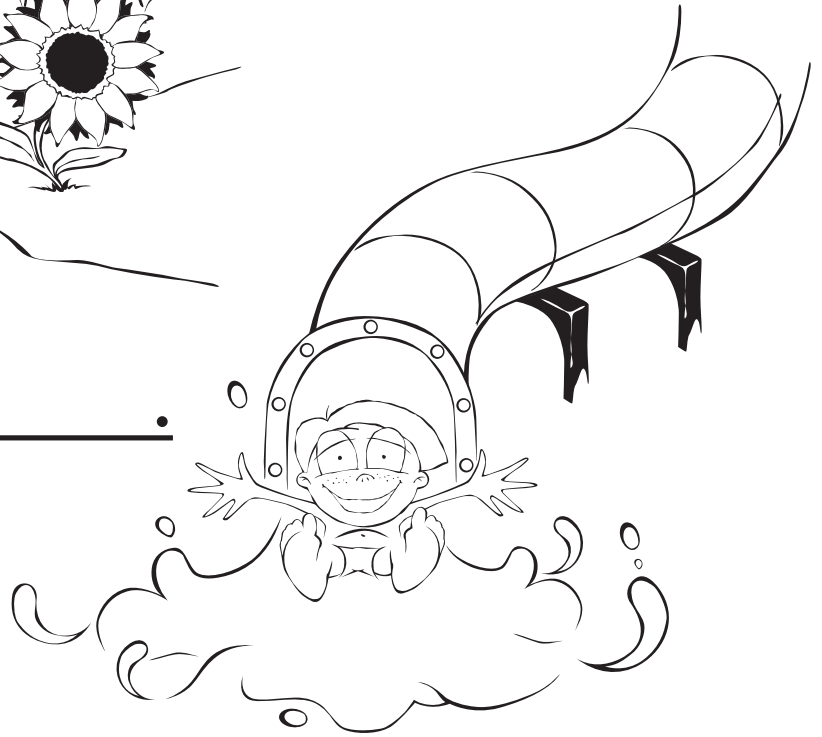
