**Question:**

Are the capital improvement projects to be used for the impact fee study developed in the most recent SAWS master plans and/or by the SAWS Engineering Department or will the consultant team develop the ten year growth related capital improvement projects independently?

**Answer:**

The Capital Improvement Projects are contained in the most recent SAWS master plans. These projects will be provided to the consultant.

**Question:**

If the consultant team is required to develop the impact fee growth related capital improvement projects independently, will the consultant team have access to the SAWS water and wastewater system hydraulic models?

**Answer:**

**Question:**

Does SAWS have their water system capital improvements plan broken out by water pressure zones?

**Answer:**

Yes, the water projects are broken out by pressure zone.

**Question:**

Does SAWS have a preference for system-wide impact fees or impact fees that vary by pressure zone (water) and by drainage area (wastewater)?

**Answer:**

Impact fees may vary by drainage area or other boundary.
