1. Submit a copy of your TCEQ issued BPAT and/or CSI License  
(Testers / Inspectors are responsible to maintain license renewals and supply SAWS with updated copies)
2. Certificate of Completion from the required BPAT 40 hour training course
3. Tester's / Inspector's Company name, address and contact numbers
4. Type of Tests you will be doing for SAWS (e.g. Fire lines, Irrigation, etc.)
5. Gauge Report Information Required for BPAT;  
Company Name of Gauge Owner (To whom does the gauge belong)  
Gauge Manufacturer  
Gauge Serial Number  
Calibration Report to verify the last calibration date of the gauge  
(Gauges are to be calibrated at least annually by certified gauge Manufacture Representative or an ABPA Certified Proctor)

**\*Any Tests / Inspections performed for SAWS by any persons not approved or having expired licenses will be deemed as unacceptable and the Tests / Inspections will be rejected.**
