

San Antonio Water System Standard Specifications for Construction

ITEM NO. 902
SAFETY AND HEALTH PROGRAM

DESCRIPTION: This item shall govern the preparation and implementation of the contractor's Safety and Health Program for the specified project. The Construction Safety and Health Program Guidance Document is not intended to be an all-inclusive listing of safety procedures. It is a guidance document outlining general safety activities, procedures, and reporting requirements for the contractor to prepare a project specific Safety and Health Plan. The contractor shall prepare and implement their project specific Safety and Health Plan throughout the construction phase of the project.

The contractor shall submit the project specific Safety and Health Plan and receive approval of the plan by SAWS prior to the beginning of the construction phase of the project.

MEASUREMENT: Measurement of the Item, "Safety and Health Program," as specified herein, will not be measured for payment.

PAYMENTS: No direct payment shall be made for incidental cost associated with preparation and implementation of the Contractor's project specific Construction Safety and Health Program.

IMPLEMENTATION: The implementation of this specification for SAWS construction projects will begin on all contracts executed after August 1, 1999.
