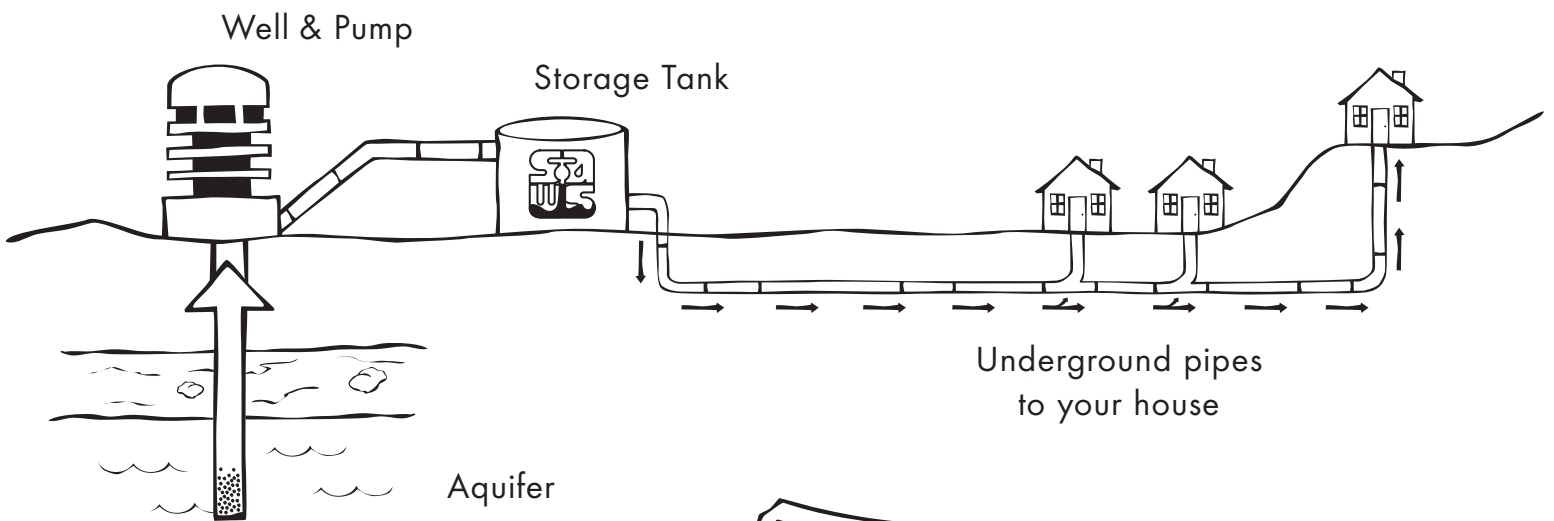


From Rain to Drain

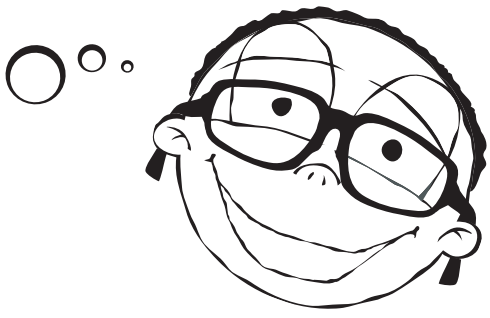

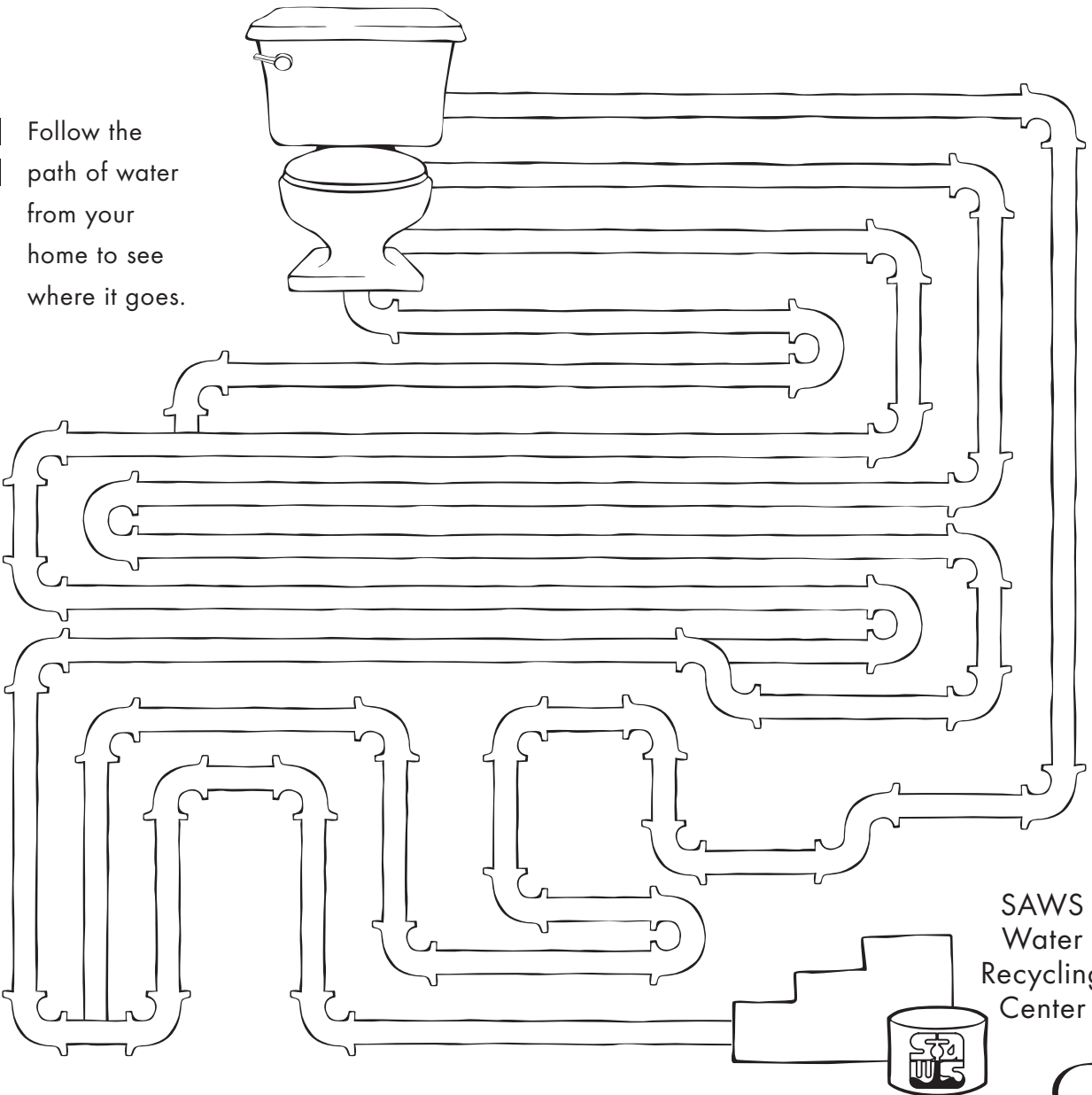


WALTER'S FAST FACT
