

Boil Water Notice Rescinded
February 20, 2021

On February 17, 2021, the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) required the San Antonio Water System PWS #0150018 to issue a Boil Water Notice to inform customers, individuals, or employees that due to conditions which occurred recently in the public water system, the water from this public water system was required to be boiled prior to use for drinking water or human consumption purposes.

As conditions improved, SAWS has taken the necessary corrective actions to restore the quality of the water distributed used for drinking water or human consumption purposes and has provided TCEQ with laboratory test results that indicate that the water in designated areas of the City no longer requires boiling prior to use as of February 20, 2021.

The following service levels have been cleared from boiling their water or these service areas no longer required to boil their water.

HGL 930/PZ 4
HGL 994/PZ 5
HGL 1111/PZ 7

(“HGL” =Hydraulic Gradient Line, “PZ” = Pressure Zone)
